SANTA CATARINA STATE UNIVERSITY - UDESC

Based in the state of Santa Catarina, southern Brazil, Udesc was founded in 1965. Its multi-campus structure is divided into 12 units spread through 9 cities in the state (Balneário Camboriú, Chapecó, Florianópolis, Itapirama, Joinville, Lages, Laguna, Pinhalzinho and São Bento do Sul).



To aid its students in fully developing their academic and practical activities, Udesc offers a complete infrastructure, with libraries and laboratories, besides information technology support in all its units.

Center for Technological Sciences (CCT)

Located on a 67 thousand m² land in the city of Joinville, the Center for Technological Sciences (CCT) is the largest of all 12 Udesc's centers. CCT's structure offers a library, a community center, a sports gymnasium and many research laboratories.

The city of Joinville has about 605 thousand inhabitants, which makes it the largest city in the state of Santa Catarina, even larger than the capital, Florianópolis, which is 130 km away. It has a high HDI (0.809), ranking 21st among all Brazilian cities, and is know for a very influent German immigration. Since metal-mechanics, textile, food, software, appliances, computers, machines and other industries are based on the region, CCT's vocation is towards programs in engineering, information technology and exact sciences, all recognized for their excellence.

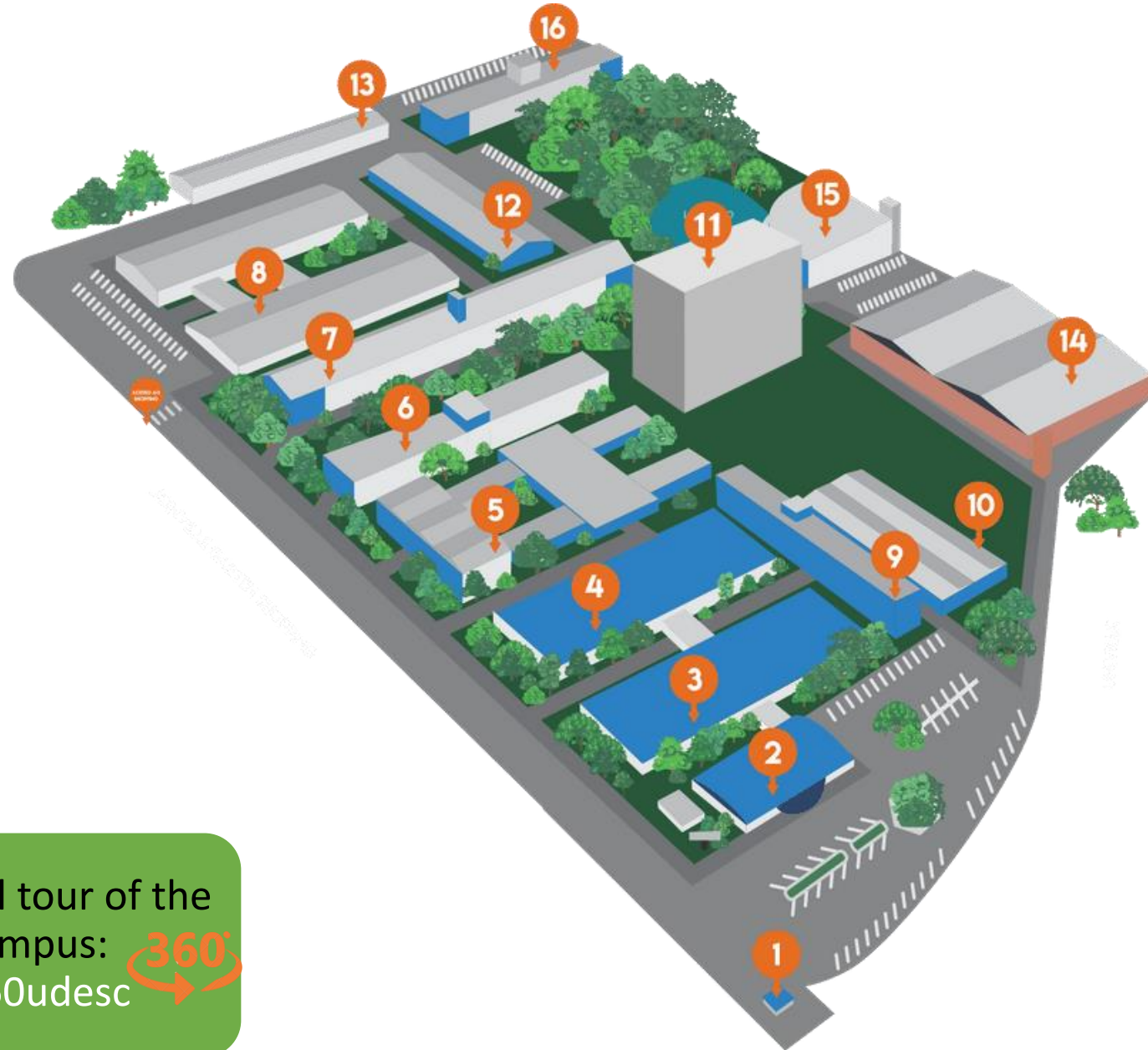

University Library – Udesc (Joinville)

- **University Library**

The University Library is a higher supplementary organ (linked to the Office of the President), which runs a network of libraries in all Udesc's campuses in the state. The network comprises the Central Library, which serves the Centers located next to Udesc's headquarters, in Florianópolis, and each of the other Centers' local libraries. The University Library offers a variety of services, including local access, book lending and access to scientific data bases. It is also possible to request a book from a different library in the network.

UDESC PROVIDES:

- Student Cafeteria



The cafeteria provides meals for lunch and dinner, both for students and visitors.



Each meal costs R\$9.30 (about 2 dollars), a much lower price than the market average.

UDESC PROVIDES:

- Information Technology Laboratories



Udesc's centers offer information technology labs – classrooms equipped with computers

which can be used for classroom activities and, usually, have open periods when they can be freely used by the students.

To use the computers, students must register at the centers' information technology coordination.

The centers also run a wifi network that gives free internet access to students using their own portable devices after registration.

Being a technology-oriented student is no excuse to neglect your physical health!

The Center for Technological Sciences offers sports facilities, such as sports and exercise gymnasiums, which are used for the practice of physical activities, for curricular Physical Education practices and for university sports in general.



UDESC PROVIDES:

- Life insurance



Udesc's graduate students with a scholarship are covered by a life insurance paid by the university.

The insurance covers personal accidents, accidental death, total or partial permanent disability caused by an accident, hospital and dental expenses, besides special collective assistance.

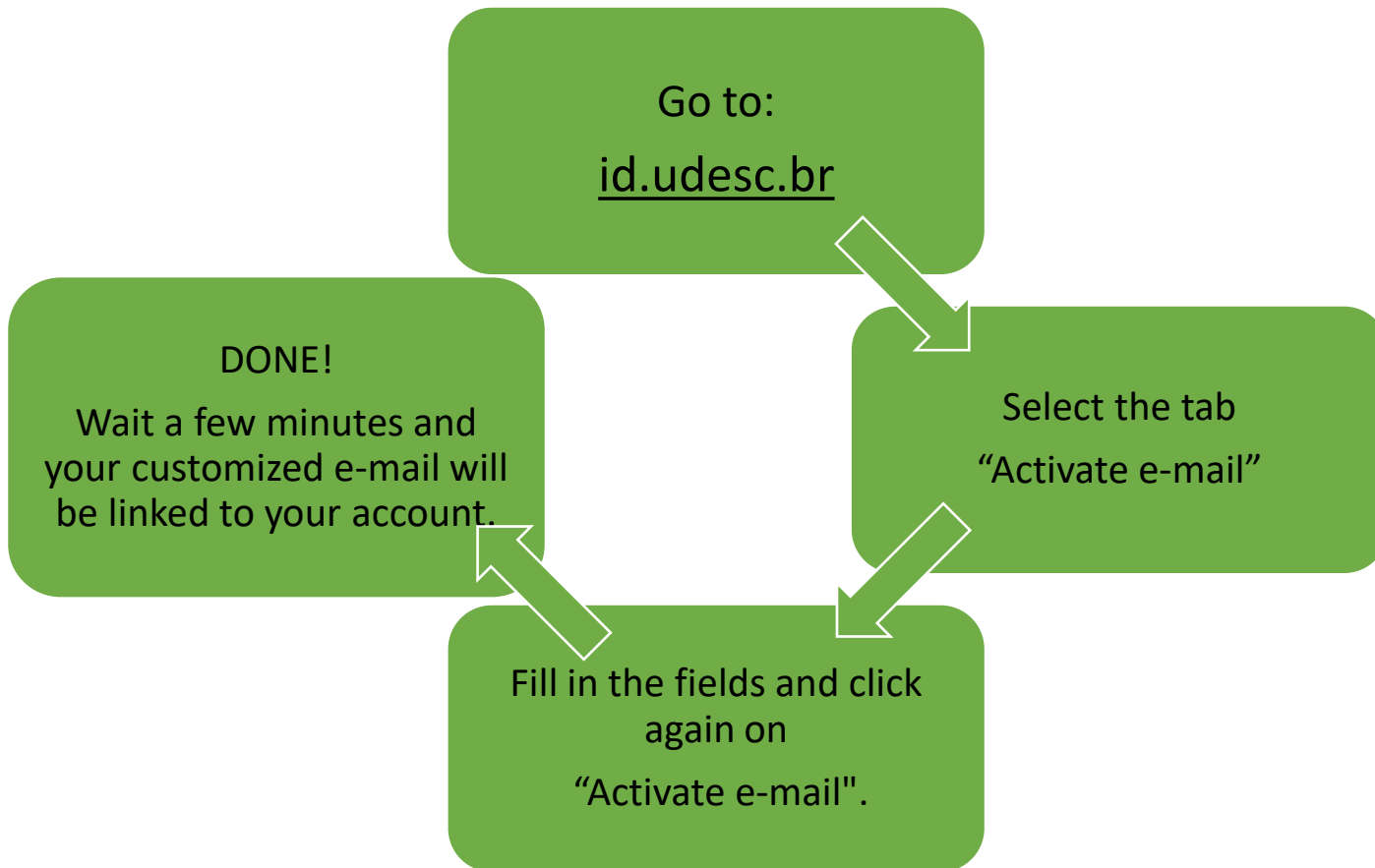
The **Academic Management System (SIGA)** is an online platform where you can find services such as enrollment application, graduate record and attendance statements without physically going to your center's graduate program's office. There, you will also find essential information for your academic life, such as grades, attendance information, performance index, courses etc.

These are some services you can access directly from SIGA:

- Request leave of absence
- Request program or course enrollment cancellation
- Validate complementary activities (using digitally-signed certificates)
- Request course validation
- Request documents (records, statements, syllabus etc.)

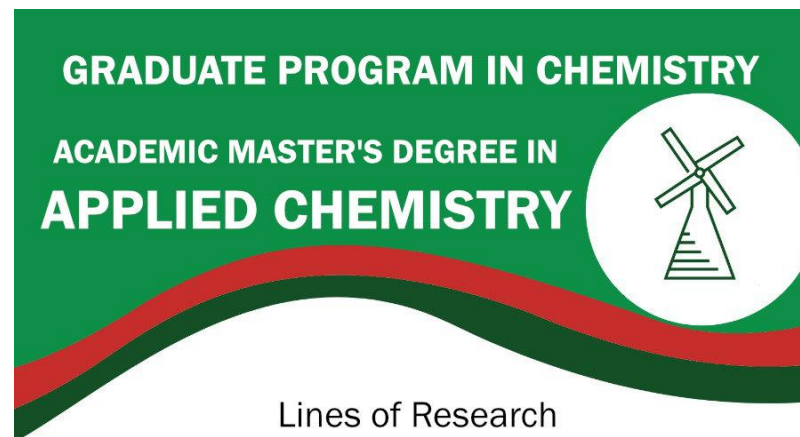

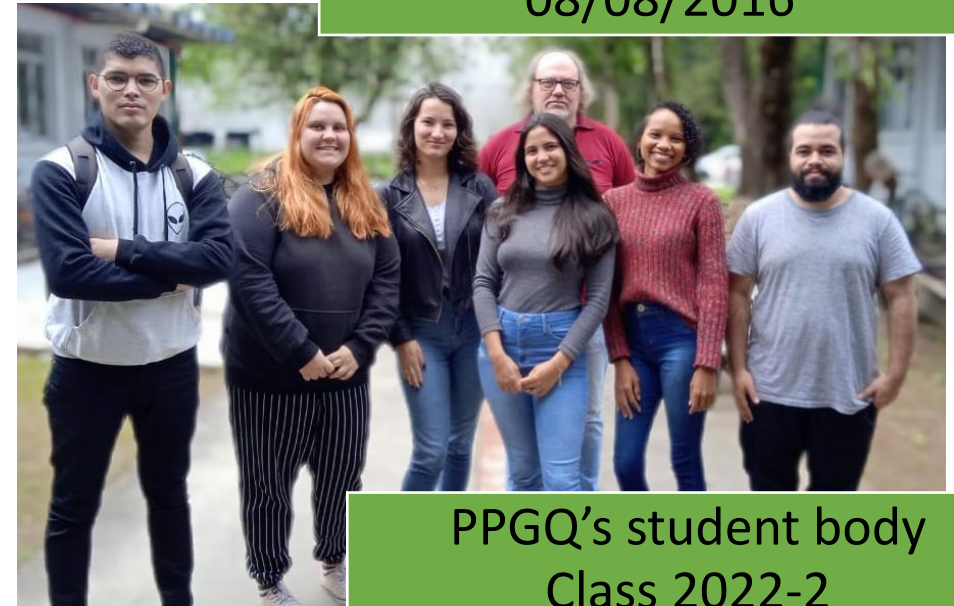


WHY CHOOSE PPGQ

How to get to the CCT



Basic information to use public transportation in Joinville:

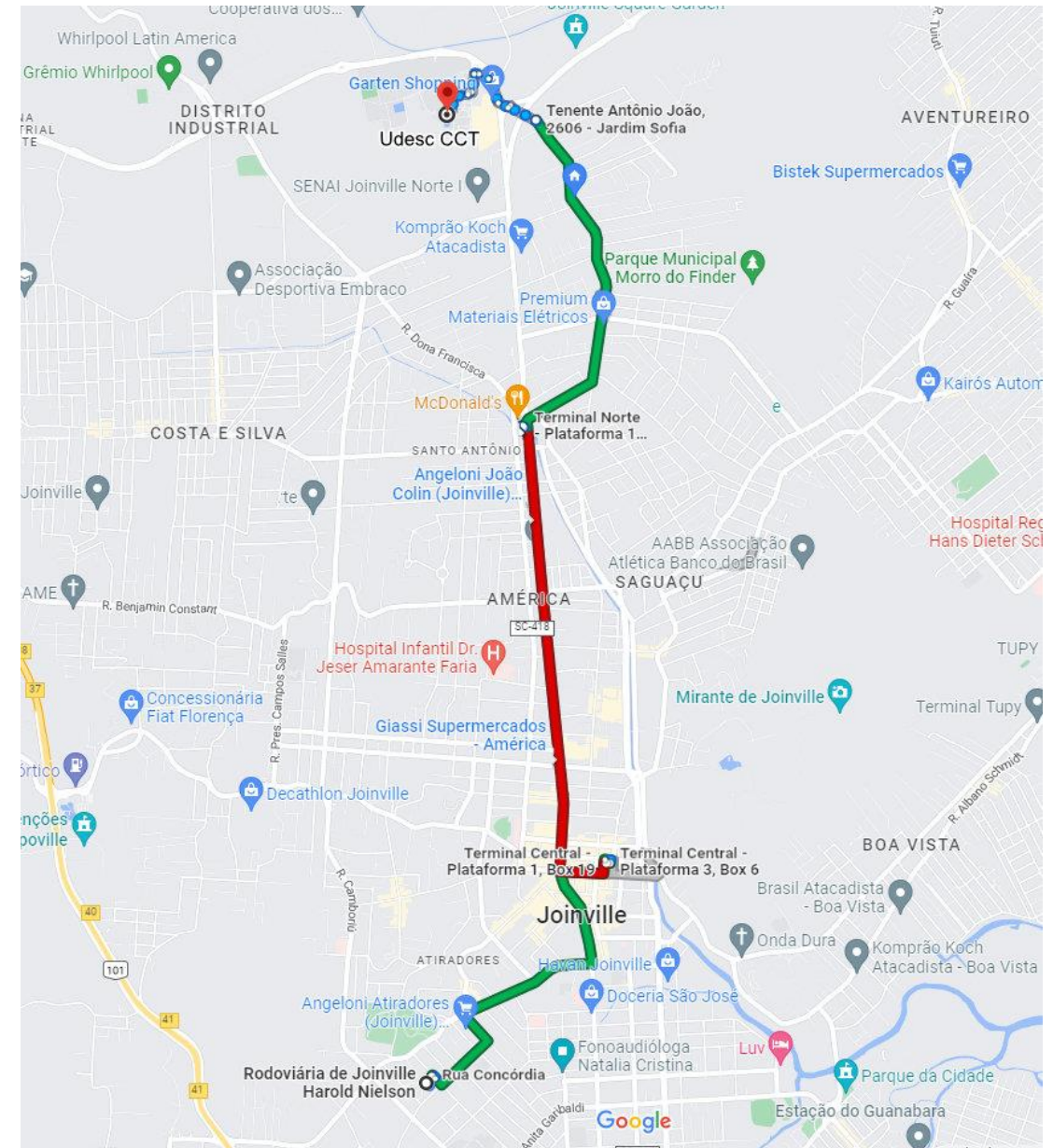
- The bus fee, when purchased in advance (reusable bus pass), costs R\$ 4.75. It can be acquired in any of the bus terminals, at the Passebus point of sale and at companies Gidion and Transtusa. Payment methods are cash, credit card, debit card or PIX (Brazilian real-time electronic money transfer system).
- To board the bus from any bus stop, you must have your previously purchased reusable bus pass or cash. For boarded cash payment, the fee is R\$ 5.00 (max change is for R\$ 50.00).
- The city has an integrated public transportation system, which means only one fee is charged if you get off one bus and board another without leaving the terminal.

How to get to the CCT?

Bus route departing from the city's bus station with connections at the Downtown and North terminals

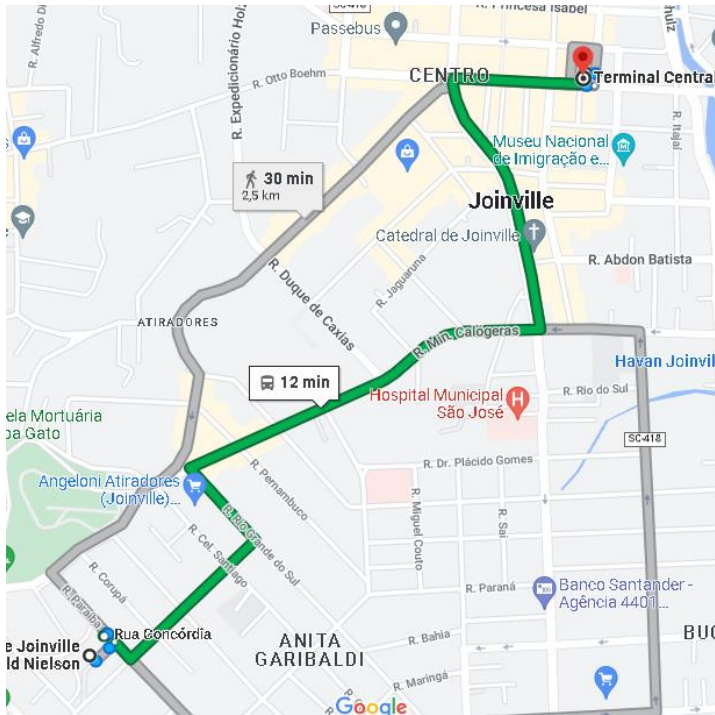
- **At the municipal bus station:** Take bus #1513 at the bus stop in front of the bus station (at Rua Paraíba) and, after about 12 minutes, get off at the Downtown terminal.
- **At the Downtown terminal:** Take bus #0041 at platform 1/box 19 and, after about 15 minutes, get off at the North terminal.
- **At the North terminal:** Take bus #0205 at platform 1/box 7 and, after about 13 minutes, get off at the University Campus bus stop. You will see Udesc's main entrance from there.

The estimated commuting time from the bus station to Udesc is approximately 70 minutes on weekdays, including the waiting time at the terminals.



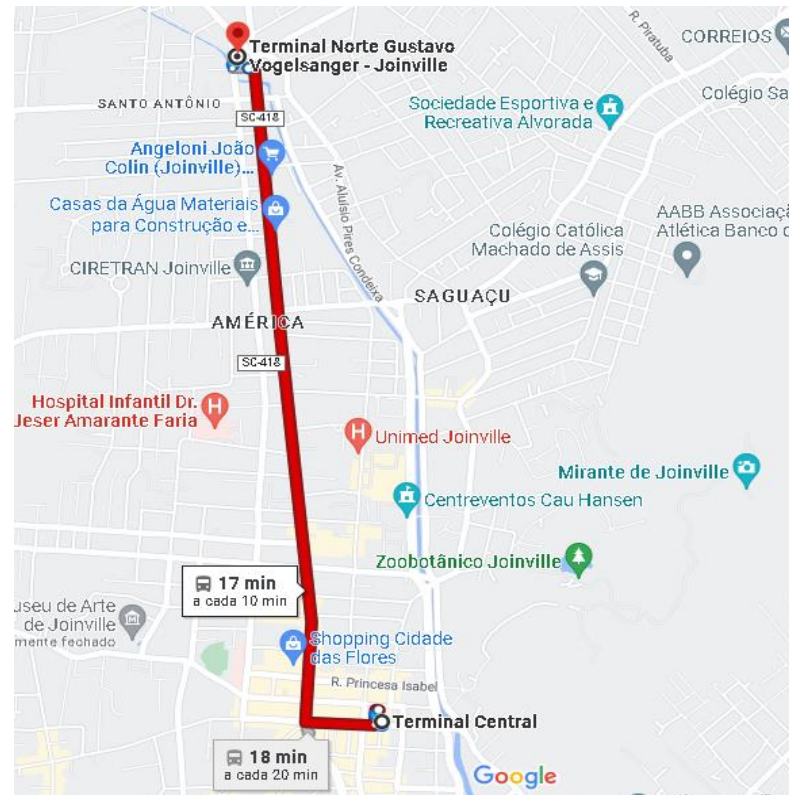
Bus route from Joinville's bus station to Udesc CCT. Source: Google Maps

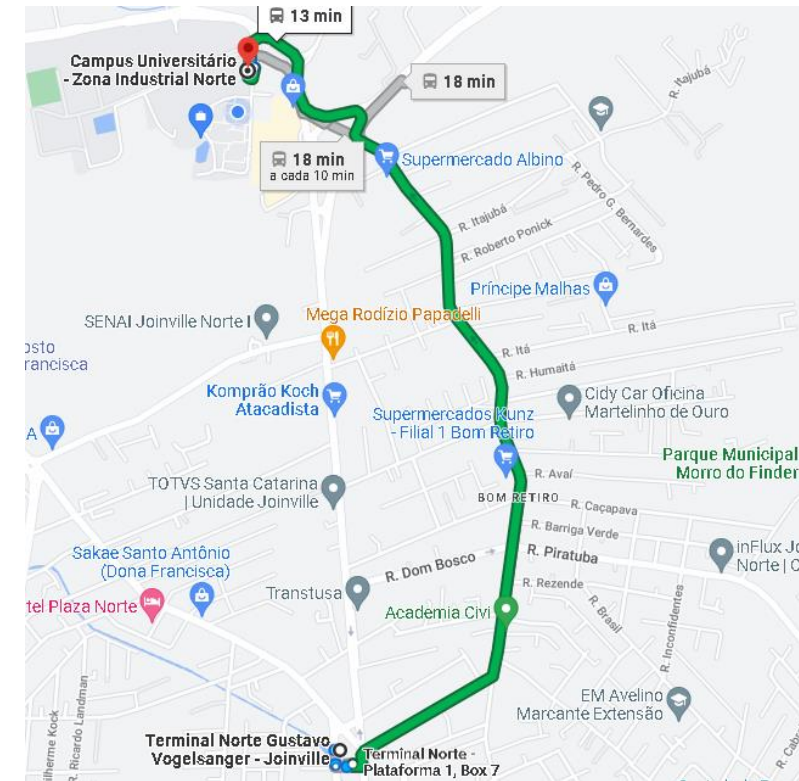


Joinville's bus station to Downtown terminal

LODGING



- There are two options: you can find people letting a bedroom in their houses or apartments, which can be easily found on Google or using AirBNB;

Proceedings to be observed by foreign students before traveling to Brazil

1. Get a Temporary Visa type IV for foreign students at your country's Brazilian embassy or consulate.
2. To request a scholarship, you must first obtain a CPF number (*Cadastro de Pessoa Física*, or Natural Person's Record) at your country's Brazilian consulate. More information is available at: http://idg.receita.fazenda.gov.br/orientacao/tributaria/cadastros/cadastro-de-pessoas-fisicas-cpf/servicos/copy_of_inscricao-no-cpf
Note: Foreign students may request their CPF number online, before arrival in Brazil, through the following address: http://www.receita.fazenda.gov.br/AutomaticoSRFsinot/2014/02/28/2014_02_28_17_34_52_1051335789.html
3. Check with the PPGQ the starting date of the class semester and the required documentation for enrollment.
Note: It's recommended to arrive at least two weeks prior to the beginning of the classes to regularize your documentation with the Federal Police, requesting your National Migration Record (RNM, from *Registro Nacional Migratório*), which will be your ID in Brazil, and to open a bank account at Banco do Brasil, which is necessary to receive the scholarship.
4. Inform PPGQ your arrival date.
5. Make sure you have enough financial resources to support your stay in Brazil for the first three months, considering that the payment of the scholarship may have some delays.
6. VACCINATION: Brazilian health surveillance agency (ANVISA, from *Agência Nacional de Vigilância Sanitária*) recommends students be vaccinated against the yellow fever before arrival, since the state of São Paulo is considered an area of risk.
7. Find temporary (or permanent) lodging on dedicated websites. Udesc does not provide student accommodations.

9. Pay attention to your rights and duties (deadlines for courses, qualification exam, Portuguese proficiency exam and dissertation defense).
